Cooking Stuff

- Fuel canisters (at least 300g)
 - 6 cups (1.5 liters) per day needs to be boiled (2cups coffee, 2cups hot cereal, 2cups dinner)
 - 13 days times 1.5 liters/day = 19.5 liters to be boiled
 - Jetboil says 10 liters per 100g canisters, so 2 100g canisters are needed
 - Bring 3 110g canisters and 1 227g canister from MSR
- Canister Crushing tool
- Lighter
- Sponge with scrubber
